Come join us for a day of camaraderie, hard work and total satisfaction...

Calling All Friends! It's time to think about spring work and the annual Volunteer Workday. This year's event is scheduled for Saturday, **June 5, 2010**, and promises to be another great day doing what we all find so fulfilling – preserving the park for future generations! Again this year, we will limit participants to 250 volunteers – don't delay. Get your reservations in at the double quick.

Projects this year include sites around the park and Eisenhower Farm. Pick your favorite activity and join us for a rewarding day. **Gettysburg National Military Park would like volunteers to clear fence lines. After all, we've built close to 11 miles of fences and now it's time to maintain them. Please sign up for our new Iron Brigade. This is not easy work, so think accordingly before your volunteer for this task (see more information on page 3).**

If you favor painting, join our **"Brush and Bucket Brigade"** at several park sites. Possible sites include the Trostle Barn, Sherfy House and, of course, we can always find fences in desperate need of a fresh coat of paint. Our **"Post and Worm Brigade"** seeks both experienced and novice volunteers to build new fencing in the Pickett's Charge area and near the McMillan House.

After the paint has dried and brushes have been cleaned, we will provide an educational walk/talk program. We are also planning a **"Visit with the Painting,"** for our evening program. Sue Boardman will conduct this Cyclorama program for an additional fee of **\$10**.

We will assign volunteers to specific projects **as registration forms are received** (similar to the spring and fall muster programs). Please complete the registration form below. **First, choose your "Brigade" preference and select your preferred task** within your brigade. If you have no work area preference, please indicate **"Reserves Brigade,"** and you will be assigned to fill in among the ranks as needed. We will make every attempt to honor your request, but registration is first come, first served. Regardless of your duties assigned, all the work is important in preserving the park for posterity. Also, we would like to form a company of around 15 strong men willing to **swing a sledge hammer** for a good part of the day. Please indicate on the sign-up form if you are willing to participate.

Every volunteer brigade needs a good medical corps. We would like to have medically trained personnel at each work site. If you are a **doctor, nurse, physician's assistant, paramedic or EMT** and wish to participate in this corps, indicate on your reservation form.

Your registration fee includes a lunch. A specially designed 2010 Volunteer Workday T-shirt will be available again this year and must be pre-ordered below. Please return your completed registration form, donation and T-shirt money to the Foundation office before **May 15, 2010**. Confirmations and additional Workday details will be mailed to participants in May.
